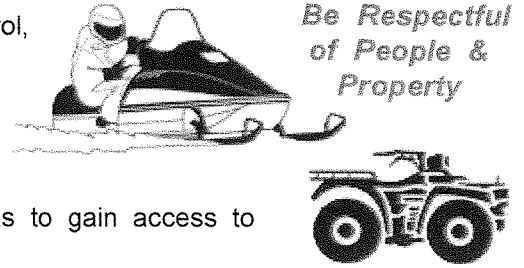

Snowmobiles/ATV Operations

Operation Prohibited. It is unlawful for any person to operate, control, or direct the cause of travel of any snowmobile or all terrain vehicle:

- (a) Upon private property without permission of the owner or person entitled to possession of such property;
- (b) Upon public sidewalks in the City except to cross such sidewalks to gain access to a street;
- (c) Within 75 feet of any skating rink, sliding area, Children playing or in any other manner where the operation would likely endanger person or property;
- (d) Upon City streets in groups exceeding six snowmobiles or all terrain vehicles or combination thereof;
- (e) Upon City streets at speeds exceeding (15) mph after sunset, (25) mph between sunrise and sunset. Under no circumstances shall any person operate a snowmobile or all terrain vehicle at a rate of speed greater than is reasonable or proper under the circumstances.
- (f) Upon the streets of the City after 11:00 p.m. unless heading directly out of the City or directly to a specific destination within the City.



Subd. 4 **Youthful Operators.** No person under the age of (14) shall operate a snowmobile or all terrain vehicle upon the City streets. No person under the age of (16) may operate a snowmobile or all terrain vehicle after 6:00 p.m. on any street within the City. No person under the age of (18) may operate a snowmobile or all terrain vehicle after 11:00 p.m. on any street within the City.

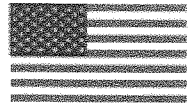
There is a drop box located at the front of the building for after hours drop offs.

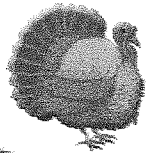
