

**AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER XII OF THE ORDINANCES
FOR THE CITY OF RICE, MINNESOTA, SAID ORDINANCE BEING ENTITLED
AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SEWER USE REGULATIONS**

Be it hereby ordained by the City Council of the City of Rice, Minnesota, that Article III of Chapter XII of the ordinances of the City of Rice is hereby amended by adding the following section to said article:

Section 6

Prior to making any connection to the City's sanitary sewer system, the individual shall apply for and obtain a permit to make said connection. Prior to obtaining said permit the individual involved shall pay to the City such connection fee as shall be designated by the City Council of the City of Rice.

Further providing that if the amount of said fee and/or access charges changes between the date of the payment of the application fee and the date on which the water and sewer for the premises is connected and opened by the City, prior to such connection, the individual involved shall pay to the City any increased application fees and/or sewer access charges prior to accessing the system.

Further providing that a permit to connect to the City's sewer system shall expire after a 90 day period, if the premises involved is not connected to the City's sewer system within said 90 day period. Upon expiration, the premises shall not be connected to the City's sewer system unless a new permit is obtained and the applicable sewer access charges paid.

THIS REVISION TO THE ORDINANCE SHALL BE EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE AND PUBLICATION AS REQUIRED BY LAW.
