

**AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER XI OF THE ORDINANCES  
FOR THE CITY OF RICE, MINNESOTA, SAID ORDINANCE BEING ENTITLED  
MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEM**

Be it hereby ordained by the City Council of the City of Rice, Minnesota, that Section 1100.03 of Chapter XI of the ordinances of the City of Rice is hereby amended by adding the following section to said article:

Section 1100.03  
Connection Application

Any party desiring water service from said utility for premises not theretofore connected with the water system shall apply for a connection on a form provided by the City Clerk. Such application shall be given an exact description of the premises to be served and shall be filed together with the payment of the hookup, connection fee and water access charges as established, from time to time by the City Council of the City of Rice.

Further providing that if the amount of said fee and/or access charges changes between the date of the payment of the application fee and the date on which the water and sewer for the premises is connected and opened by the City, prior to such connection, the individual involved shall pay to the City any increased application fees and/or water access charges prior to accessing the system.

Further providing that a permit to connect to the City's water system shall expire after a 90 day period, if the premises involved is not connected to the City's water system within said 90 day period. Upon expiration, the premises shall not be connected to the City's water system unless a new permit is obtained and the applicable water access charges paid.

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE AND PUBLICATION AS REQUIRED BY LAW.
